

## **Creative Corner Service Update FAQ**

### **What is changing?**

The **Creative Corner is closing**, and the **3D Printshop service is ending**. This means **self-guided, drop-in use of Creative Corner equipment will no longer be available**.

### **Why is Creative Corner closing?**

The library regularly reviews its services to make sure they are well used, sustainable, and meeting community needs. Through this review, we found that:

- Creative Corner equipment was being used very infrequently
- The services required significant staff time and technical support
- Some of the technology is aging and would need reinvestment
- The space can be better used for future services that reach more people

These changes help us use our space and staff time in ways that best serve the community.

### **Which services and equipment are affected?**

Public self-guided use of the following will end:

- 3D Printshop service
- Cricut vinyl and paper cutter
- Creative Station computer and software
- VHS digitization station
- Button maker
- Wacom drawing tablet
- Arduino kits
- 

### **Is the library moving away from creativity or technology?**

No. Supporting learning, creativity, and digital literacy remains an important part of our work. This change reflects a shift away from a **self-directed makerspace model**, toward services that better match how our community is using the library today.

### **When will these changes take effect?**

Creative Corner services are expected to end **April 17, 2026**. Equipment will be removed as the space is prepared for future use. Final **3D printing jobs must be submitted by April 15, 2026**.
