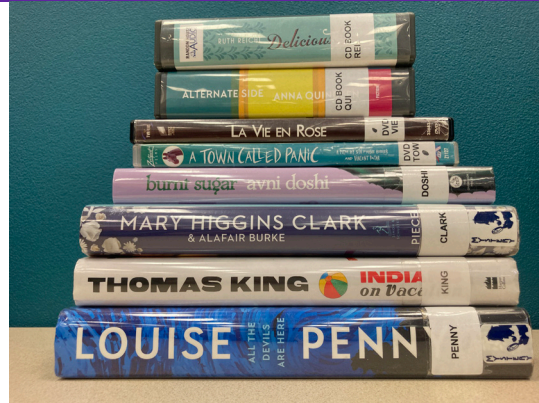


# All about Homebound Library Service

### 6 week loan

- Large print books
- CD books
- Playaways
- Magazines
- Music CDs
- DAISY books & readers

### 3 week loan

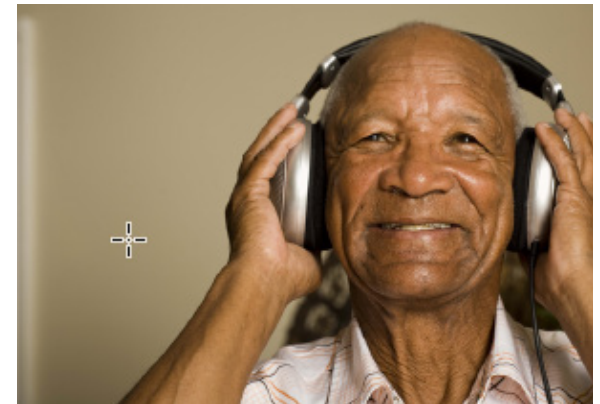
- Movies & TV series
